

Illinois Dermatological Society Privacy Policy

The Illinois Dermatological Society (“IDS”) has created this policy in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to the privacy of members, individuals with whom we do business and visitors to our website. The following discloses our information gathering and dissemination practices for www.IllinoisDermSociety.org (“Web Site”) and for IDS in general.

We use information collected, including on the Web Site, only for IDS purposes. We deploy technology and/or procedures to protect the information you send us. If cookies are used, it only is to keep track of information to allow a better user experience, and this information is kept confidential within IDS.

The Web Site incorporates forms for members and other users to request information, access certain services and to register on-line for various programs. We may collect visitors’ contact information (such as email or physical addresses) or financial information (such as credit card numbers). Unique identifiers (such as identification numbers which we have assigned) are used to verify the user's identity. We do not collect or utilize Social Security numbers. Contact information from order forms or surveys is used to send confirmations and information about IDS to our members and other users, and to analyze Web Site use for our own internal purposes. Financial information that is collected is used to bill the user for services they have requested. At all times, credit card transactions are PCI compliant. Credit card information is not retained by us when entered online, and when such information is provided in a paper format, we retain it only as long as necessary to complete the intended transaction. Documents with credit card data are altered or shredded to safeguard that information.

Our Web Site may use cookies to keep track of your shopping cart. We also may use cookies to save and verify your password information if you choose to remain logged in over multiple visits.

The Web Site contains links to other sites. In the event you choose to access such third party web sites, IDS and its Web Site are not responsible for any actions or policies of such third parties. We recommend that you check the applicable privacy policy of third parties before providing personally identifiable information to it, as its privacy policy may differ from our policies.

IDS endeavors to protect your e-mail address from inappropriate use. We do not sell or give lists of email addresses we have in our files to third-parties; this information is maintained only for the use of IDS itself. Users may opt-out of receiving future IDS group emails by following “unsubscribe” instructions which usually are included in group emails, or by contacting IDS’ administrative office.

We work to maintain appropriate security measures to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control.
